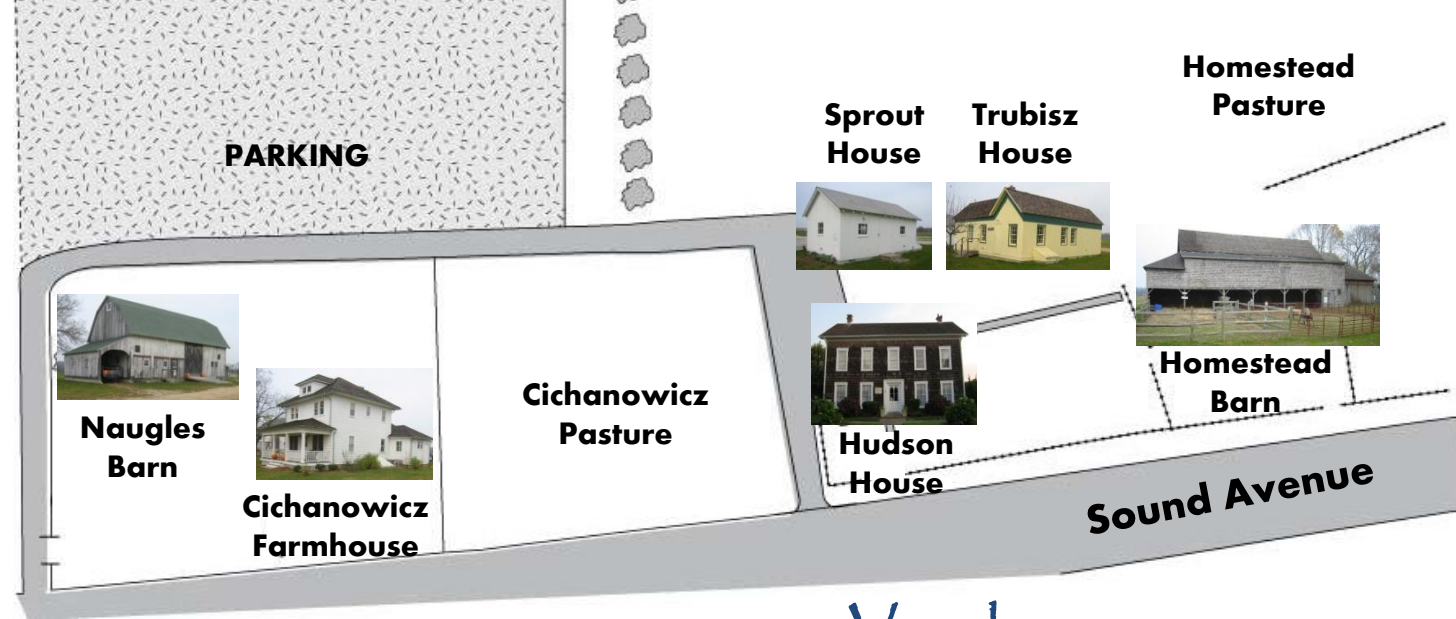

Description of Activities

Shearing- Tabbethia Haubold of the Long Island Livestock Company expertly harvests fiber from sheep and llamas.

Herding- Joan McGrath and Judianne Davis work with their border collies in a fascinating demonstration of sheep herding.

Carding- Diane Burgert demonstrates how tangled fiber is processed into material ready for spinning.

Spinning/Drop spindle- Ellen Sullivan, Patti Edwards, and other members of the Spinning Study Group of Long Island show how to turn fiber into yarn.

Dyeing- Christine Thorpe-Henson and Debbie Johnson explain how natural fibers can be colorfully transformed using acid and natural dyes.

Weaving- Donna Trunk weaves on the Hallockville looms and explains the differences between fleece, fiber, and hair.

Knitting- sit a spell with the Hallockville Knitters and learn the basics of this relaxing and rewarding craft.

Felting- Irene Heckel-Volpe shows another interesting way of using wool to create wonderful pieces.

Rug Hooking- the Peconic Ruggers practice a folk art that dates back to the American Revolution.

Basket Weaving- Barbara Blossy-Chuvalas shares her passion for using plant fibers to create wonderful baskets.

Llama Obstacle Course- watch these wonderful animals as they display their fancy footwork.

Animal Display- our friends at the Suffolk County Farm show off some of their great animals.

Rabbits- Lisa Konnerth of Bay Haven Angoras and Patricia Kubler of Firelight Rabbitry show off their beautiful rabbits.
